






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### Tenure; Householder 65 or Older Portion of Income for Housing Cost




#### Income; Householder 65 years and over




#### Income by Tenure; Householder 65 Years and Over

### Demand for Apartments

- 40 million persons age 65 or older
- ¾ homeowners
- 10 million senior renters
- 2 million in assisted living or nursing homes
